4. Read the given case study and answer the following questions that follow.

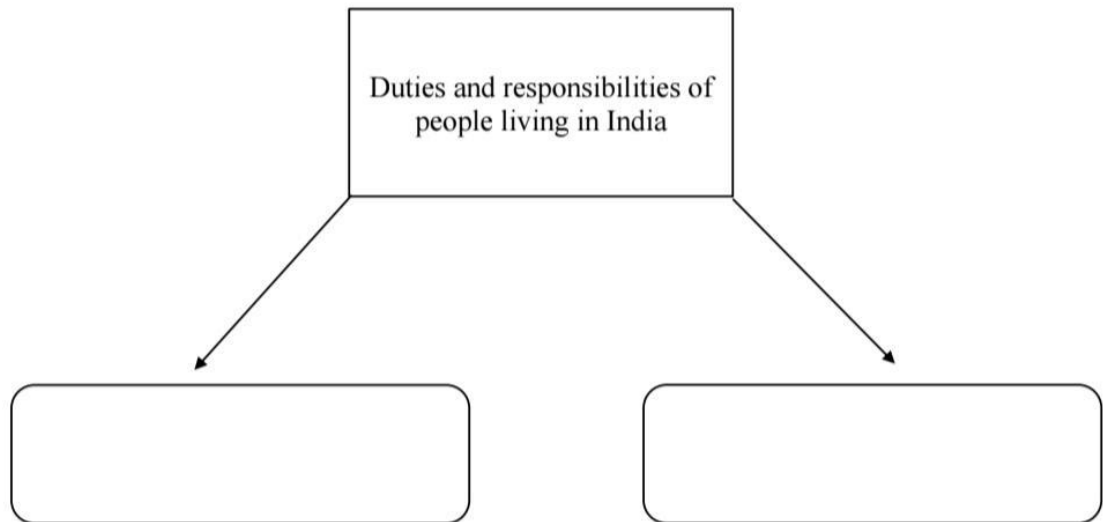
