

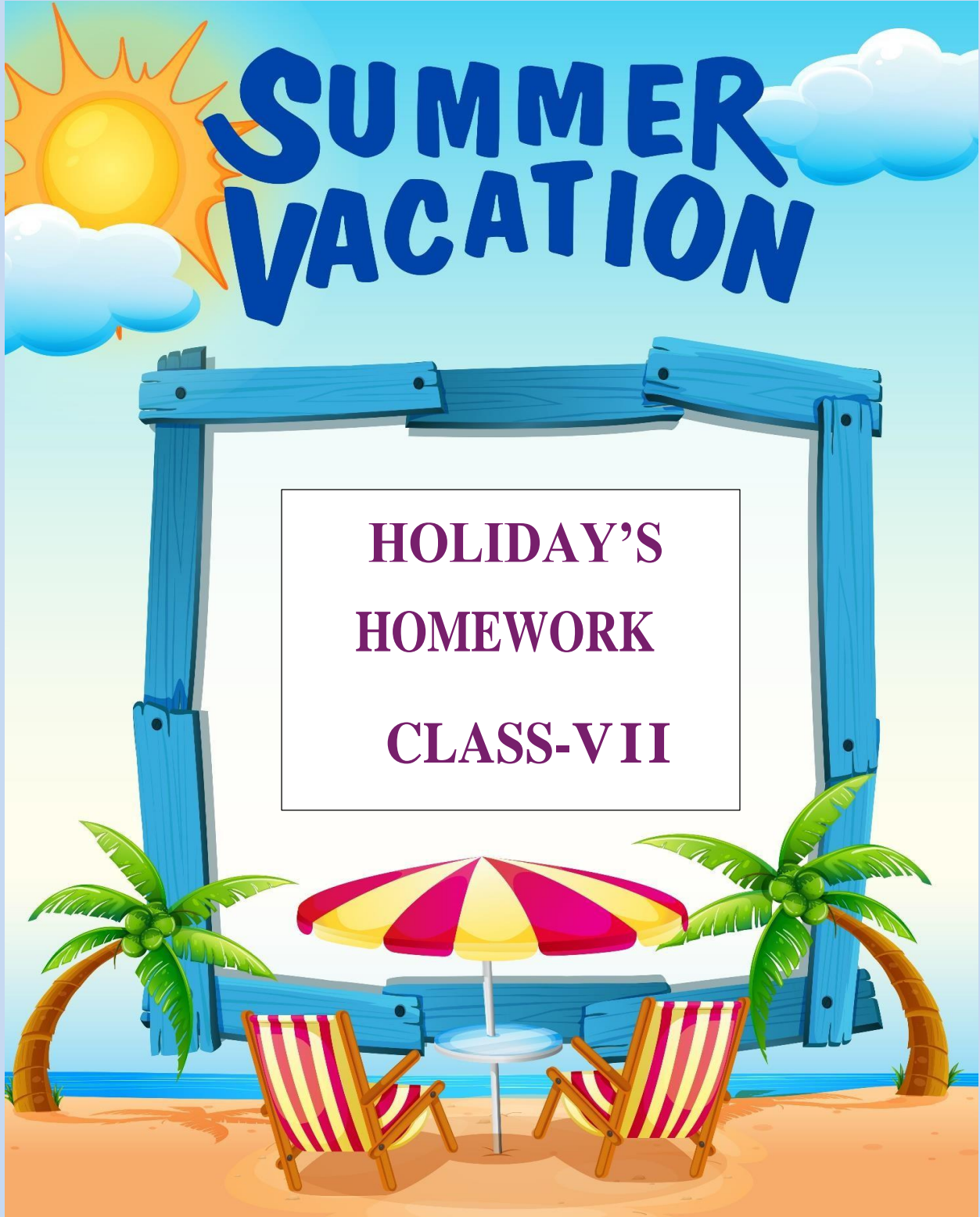

Summer holidays are here to refresh your mind and body. While you enjoy mangoes, games, and family time, let's also keep our English grammar sharp. This 10-day plan needs just 30 minutes daily. Learn a little, write a little, and become a Grammar Champ!

Instructions:

Tick after finishing each day. Use one thin notebook. Write neatly.

*Day 1: Simple Tenses + Paragraph

Grammar: Write formula + 1 example for Simple Present, simple past and simple future.

Paragraph: Write 5 lines on "My Summer Morning".

Day 2: Continuous Tenses + Paragraph

Grammar: Write formula + 1 example for Present Continuous, Past Continuous, Future Continuous.

Paragraph: Write 5 lines on "What I Am Doing This Holiday".

Day 3: Perfect Tenses + Paragraph

Grammar: Write formula + 1 example for Present Perfect, Past Perfect, Future Perfect.

Paragraph: Write 5 lines on "A Trip I Have Enjoyed".

Day 4: Sentence Parts + Paragraph

Grammar: Divide into Subject and Predicate:

1. The little bird on the tree sings sweetly.
2. My friends and I play every evening.
3. To speak the truth is a good habit.

Paragraph: Write 5 lines on "My Best Friend".

Day 5: Phrases + Paragraph

Grammar: Write 1 Noun Phrase, 1 Adjective Phrase, 1 Adverb Phrase. Use each in a sentence.

Paragraph: Write 5 lines on "My Favourite Place at Home".

Day 6: Kinds of Sentences + Paragraph

Grammar: Write 1 example each of Assertive, Interrogative, Imperative, Exclamatory. Use correct punctuation.

Paragraph: Write 5 lines on "If I Had a Magic Wand".

*Day 7: Nouns + Paragraph

Grammar: Make 5 columns: Proper, Common, Collective, Abstract, Material Noun. Write 2 examples each.

Paragraph: Write 5 lines on "A Visit to the Market".

Day 8: Pronouns + Paragraph

Grammar: Write 5 kinds of pronouns with 1 example: Personal, Possessive, Demonstrative, Interrogative, Indefinite.

Paragraph: Write 5 lines on "How I Help My Mother" using at least 3 pronouns. Underline them.
